In a speech before the
National Center for

UN Population Fund, and other non-governmental organizations hosted, Int'l Conference on Population and Development Global Youth Forum. Reps of Int'l Planned Parenthood Federation, World YWCA, and the World Association of Girl Scouts and Girl Guides were on the steering committee. The "outcome document" recommended worldwide decriminalization of abortion and prostitution, comprehensive sex including homosexuality and government's recognition of "constantly evolving" concept of family.

New Queen James Bible - The editors explain in a statement that they took each of the eight Bible verses traditionally used to argue that homosexuality is sinful, and edited them "in a way that makes homophobic interpretations impossible." Other than the eight verses in question, the Bible uses the King James translation verbatim. The title is based on a theory that King James was bisexual.
