### **News From Around PA**

**Congresswoman Allyson Schwartz** (PA-13th) discussed the Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting in Newtown, Connecticut, on C-SPAN's *Washington Journal*. One caller said, "Roe v. Wade took away the right to life. We encourage the culture of death by giving money to Planned Parenthood." Schwartz responded, "I don't see the connection here."

**Congressman Charlie Dent** (PA-15th) is one of three Republican co-sponsors of a "gay" immigration bill which would equate "marriages" between Americans and their 'gay' foreign partners with real marriage, thus easing restrictions on their entry into the country.

### **News from National Scene**
