Congresswoman Allyson Schwartz (PA-13th) discussed the Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting in Newtown, Connecticut, on C-SPAN's Washington Journal. One caller said, "Roe v. Wade took away the right to life. We encourage the culture of death by giving money to Planned Parenthood." Schwartz responded, "I don't see the connection here."
