News from National Scene The Abstinence Education Reallocation Act was introduced in the House by Rep. Randy Hultgren (R-IL) and Rep. Daniel Lipinski (D-IL). Senator Lindsey Graham (R-SC) plans to introduce the bill in the Senate. It will require that at least 40 percent of funding be used for training and technical assistance for abstinence education.

A Supreme Court decision last year upheld the FCC's authority to fine TV stations for airing indecent material, but the agency has shown little interest in exercising that power.
