News From Around PA
East Norriton (Montgomery County) recently appointed four members to the Human Relations Commission which was formed when a homosexual special rights ordinance passed in 2012.

HR 17, a resolution recognizing April 30 as a "National Fast Day," passed out of the House State Government Committee on February 13 by a 15-8 vote.

John Callahan, pro-homosexual Bethlehem mayor, has announced his candidacy for Northampton County Executive.

The Liberty City LGBT Democratic Club has set its agenda for 2013. It includes "statewide LGBT-inclusive anti-discrimination law,

reproductive justice, transgender documentation and recognition, social justice and economic empowerment for the LGBT community."

No photo ID will be required in order to vote in the May 21st primary.

News from National Scene
The Abstinence Education Reallocation Act was introduced in the House by Rep. Randy Hultgren (R-IL) and Rep. Daniel Lipinski (D-IL). Senator Lindsey Graham (R-SC) plans to introduce the bill in the Senate. It will require that at least 40 percent of funding be used for training and technical assistance for abstinence education.

A Supreme Court decision last year upheld the FCC's authority to fine TV stations for airing indecent material, but the agency has shown little interest in exercising that power.

Congressman Mike Kelly (PA-03) has introduced the "Advice and Consent Restoration Act" which would block further action taken by the National Labor

Relations Board and blocks the pay of the three members unconstitutionally appointed by Obama.

National Geographic Channel is coming under fire from the **Gay and Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation** who is demanding that they add a disclaimer to the start of each episode of the upcoming reality show "Are You Tougher Than a Boy Scout?"

Orson Scott Card, a writer for DC Comic's Superman series, has come under attack by homosexual activists because he opposes same-sex "marriage." They are demanding he be fired.
