News From Around PA

A Conshohocken steel worker and his husband filed suit in federal court this week after the employee was barred from adding his spouse to his health-insurance plan.

On January 16 **State Rep Gregory Lucas** (R-Erie) introduced HB 122 which would permit school personnel with a concealed carry permit to take their firearm on school property.

State Senator Lloyd Smucker (R-West Lampeter) plans to introduce the PA Dream Act which would allow students who were brought to the United States illegally as children to be eligible for instate tuition to the state universities.

A Nazareth woman who attended graduate classes tuition at Lehigh free University is suing for \$1.3 million more from college because, she claims, a poor grade in one class diminished her lifetime earning potential. She said she received a C+ because is "an outspoken she supporter of gay and lesbian marriage rights." The judge allowed the grade to stand.

A federal district court has finally dismissed the ACLU's six-year-old challenge against a Ten Commandments monument in Dixie County, Florida. As part of the court-ordered dismissal, the ACLU will have to pay court costs caused by its failed lawsuit.

The U.S. Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, created by Dodd-Frank, is weighing

whether it should take on a role in "helping" Americans manage the \$19.4 trillion they have put into retirement savings i.e. 401Ks.

Wall Street Journal on the sequestration scheduled for March 1st: Voters should scoff at the idea that a \$3.6 government can't save one nickel of every federal dollar agencies spend. The \$85 billion in savings is a mere 2.3% of total spending. Agencies that the White House says can't save 5% received an average increase in their budgets of 17% in the previous five years—not counting their \$276 billion stimulus bonus.\_
