News From Around PA Abington Health has announced plans to merge with Holy Redeemer. However 150 physicians from Abington have expressed dismay because abortions will stop then.

The Boston Consulting Group has identified sixty Philadelphia school buildings as candidates for closure and up private helped line vendors willing to replace the school district's unionized workforce at a \$50 million discount.

Governor Corbett has said he wants to reduce harm to citizens brought about by the implementation of Obamacare. However, he currently plans to create state health exchanges -something that is not mandated by Obamacare. Federal dollars will pour into the state the first two years,
