News From Around PA There were 3400 cases of child abuse in PA in 2011: over 1700 were child sexual abuse! Statistics show that porn consumption plays a major role in child sexual abuse. The AFA of PA has contacted Attorney General Linda Kelly's office asking her to, at a minimum, contact each municipality in PA encouraging them to pass and zoning licensing ordinances to regulate sexually oriented businesses.
