News From Around PA Cradle of Liberty Scout Council in Philadelphia: in 2010, a federal jury ruled that the city's eviction attempt was against the Scouts' first-amendment of right expressive association. In March 2012, U.S. District Judge Ronald L. Buckwalter upheld the jury verdict, and also ordered the city to pay the Scouts \$877,000 in legal fees.
