New from National Scene

On Tuesday **Senator Bob Casey, Jr.** voted to end the filibuster of Roe v. Wade architect Andrew Hurwitz for judge on the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. Hurwitz' confirmation vote will now move ahead.

Rep. Robert Dold (R-Ill.), has introduced the "Protecting Women's Access to Health Care Act," a bill that would shield abortion providers from attempts to strip the federal funding they receive through the Title X.

Paul Singer, a hedge fund billionaire and prominent Republican donor, is looking to create his own outside organization that would encourage GOP candidates to support "gay" marriage.

US House has voted to stop the Obama administration from arranging abortions at taxpayer expense for illegal immigrants who are detained by customs officials.

University of Texas sociology professor Mark Regnerus

said in his study published in Social Science Research when compared with adults raised in married, mother-father families, adults raised by lesbian mothers had negative outcomes in 24 of 40 categories, while adults raised by 'gay' fathers had negative outcomes in 19.
