On Tuesday Senator Bob
Casey, Jr. voted to end the
filibuster of Roe v. Wade
architect Andrew Hurwitz for
judge on the Ninth Circuit
Court of Appeals. Hurwitz'
confirmation vote will now

Rep. Robert Dold (R-III.), has introduced the "Protecting Women's Access to Health Care Act," a bill that would shield abortion providers from attempts to strip the federal funding they receive through the Title X.
