HB 818, which became law
on June 17th, ensures
Pennsylvania opts out of
abortion funding under the
health insurance exchange
created by Obamacare.

Congressman Charlie Dent (R-Lehigh) blasted his colleagues for their decision to move forward on a bill that would implement a nationwide ban on abortions after 20 weeks.

A group of students from Pittsburgh **Brashear High School** was commended by city council for its work in creating a Gay Straight Alliance Club.

As part of a legal agreement, a plaque in honor of the **Boy Scouts of America** will be installed on or near the Cradle of Liberty Scout Council Headquarters in

Philadelphia. They will be vacating the building the end of June. Homosexual activists are not pleased about the plaque.
