News From Around PA

Cumberland County Magisterial District Judge Mark Martin dismissed harassment charges against a Muslim who allegedly attacked an atheist dressed as a "Muhammad zombie" during last October's Mechanicsburg Halloween Parade. The judge browbeat the plaintiff saying he had insulted Islamic religion.

Bob Langley, a City of Meadville resident since 2008, was named to fill a vacancy on City Council. The *Erie Gay News* extends their congratulations and reports that "Bob's partner, John Despo, was also at the swearing in ceremony on February 15." Cradle of Liberty Scout Council vs. Philadelphia

Attorneys have asked a federal judge to reject COLBSA's request for more than \$1 million in legal fees. In 2010 the Scouts won a federal lawsuit against the city which had been trying since 2003 to evict them from the headquarters they built and have maintained since 1929 on property the 1928 City Council gave them free use of "forever." Why? Because they do not permit homosexual leaders or members. In a Nov. 2010 agreement reached by City Law Dept., but never approved by City Council, the Scouts would have dropped the \$1 million demand in legal fees in exchange for being allowed to purchase the HQ for \$500,000. Philly's action is a direct result of the Fair Practices Ordinance which contains "sexual orientation."

New Federal Guidelines from the White House require immigration agents to provide taxpayer-funded abortion, transportation to the abortion clinic, and transgender hormone therapy for illegal aliens awaiting deportation.
