News From Around PA The Human Rights Campaign released its 2013 Municipal Equality Index, which rates a municipality in "its fight for equality on behalf of the community," LGBT and Philadelphia was one of 25 US cities receiving 100. New Hope received an 89, Harrisburg a 76, Pittsburgh a 72, State College a 63 and Allentown а 50.

U.S. District Court Judge John E. Jones III denied requests by the state Department of Health and the Bucks County Register of Wills to dismiss the ACLU lawsuit against our Defense of Marriage Act. He said the institution of marriage has seen a "sea change" and that "significant doctrinal developments" had occurred since the 1972 US Supreme Court decision saying marriage was a state, not federal issue.

"Building Momentum for Change: How Local and Incremental Policy Campaigns Contribute to Statewide Victories," funded by The Gill Foundation, found " in addition to protections securing for LGBT people, local policies campaigns and helped provide opportunities to engage in productive public education, establish facts that facilitate creating a case for more legislation and create political momentum for LGBT issues."
