**News From Around PA**  
**Arizona Gov. Jan Brewer** is the latest Republican to reject a state-based insurance exchange under Obamacare. Governor Corbett has yet to make any announcement. (Note: although he has announced he wants to expand gambling!)

**Penn State's former president, Graham Spanier**, will receive nearly \$3.3 million in compensation for 2011, including a \$1.2 million severance payment following his forced resignation.

**Prudhomme's Lost Cajun Kitchen** in Lancaster County must also include "religious atheists" in their 10% Sunday discounts. The PA Human Relations Commission ruling says the restaurant must

accept bulletins "from any group oriented around the subject of religious faith, including publications from the Freedom From Religion Foundation . . . ."

**President Obama has nominated 3 judges** to take the bench in PA's eastern district. Their jurisdiction would include Berks, Bucks, Chester, Lehigh, Delaware, Lancaster, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia counties. The PA Student Equality Coalition is thrill because one nominee, Nitza I. Quiñones Alejandro, is a lesbian. Both Senators Casey and Toomey say they support all three nominees.

**News from National Scene**  
**The ACLU recently filed a lawsuit** on behalf of four female military service members to challenge the Pentagon's ban on women serving in direct frontline combat units. The lawsuit, filed in federal court in San Francisco, is the second such filed in federal court this year

Liberty Counsel is challenging the **new California law** which bans any therapy that helps one overcome unwanted same-sex attraction. The law

also prohibits parents from seeking therapy for children who may be sexually confused. A California Congresswoman has introduced a Sense of the Congress Resolution asking Congress to condemn such therapy and encourage all states to pass laws similar to the new one in California.

Ultra-liberal, pro-homosexual **Southern Poverty Law Center** has sued JONAH (Jews Offering New Alternatives of Healing) for consumer fraud. They allege that the therapy, which is designed to help homosexuals who want to overcome unwanted same-sex attraction, has failed.
