American Legion Post 311 in Hawley is taking a stand: If prayer by its chaplain is not allowed, Legion members won't be participating in the annual Veterans Day ceremony at Wallenpaupack Area High School on Nov. 11.

Pennsylvania public school districts would be required to post "In God We Trust" in every school building under legislation sponsored by Allegheny County Rep. Rick Saccone. The bill passed the House Education Committee by a 14-to-9 vote.

Earlier this month open homosexual PA State Representative Brian Sims attended the Gay Lesbian Straight Education Network (GLSEN) Respect Awards in Beverly Hills. Afterwards he held fundraisers for his reelection in San Francisco, San Diego and Los Angeles.
