News From Around PA
The state legislature is
considering a measure that

The end of March the **Transgender Day of Visibility** was held at Norris Square Park in North Philly. Deputy Commissioner Myron Patterson, who took over as police LGBT liaison January, stood next to Jo Mason during his speech. He held a sign that said "Proud Ally" over the transgender flag. Mason is the president of the Greater Philadelphia Gay Officer Action League.

Pine Richland School District (Allegheny County)

does not have a specific policy on students who identify as transgender, but currently the district allows such students to use the bathroom of the gender they identify with, or a private bathroom, such as one in the nurse's office. Some parents have expressed concerns about safety, others have hired lawyers to force the school do more. informational meeting is to be held on April 21st.

**News from National Scene** The Michigan State Board of Education has proposed voluntary quidelines "make LGBT students feel more comfortable," including allowing students to use whichever bathroom "aligns with their sexual identity." This is being pushed by the student president of one school's Gay Straight Alliance Club. Surprise! Surprise!

Mississippi Governor Phil Bryant signed the **Religious** Freedom Law which will sincerely "protect held religious beliefs and moral convictions of individuals, organizations and private associations from discriminatory action by state government or its political subdivisions, which would include counties, cities, and institutions of higher learning." As he explained, it reinforces the right outlined in the First Amendment of the US Constitution.
