News From Around PA House The State will continue its impeachment investigation of recentlyresigned Attorney General Kathleen Kane in an effort to highlight other any misconduct that wasn't covered by her criminal trial.

Campus Pride has named the University of Pennsylvania and Penn State to a top-30 list of LGBT-friendly campuses.

PA's newly redesigned Prescription Drug Monitoring Program is running, with the hope it will serve as an important tool to help curb prescription drug abuse.

The union representing 5,500 faculty and coaches at PA's **14 state universities** voted unanimously to hold votes on striking or not.

News from National Scene A new WPA national poll asking adults whether the government should force organizations to **open bathrooms** and other facilities to people of the opposite sex shows 66% disapprove, with over half showing strong disapproval.

The Ford Foundation and Borealis Philanthropy recently announced the formation of the Black Led Movement Fund, a six-year pooled donor campaign aimed at raising \$100 million for the Movement for Black Lives coalition. The Fund "provides grants, movement building resources, and technical assistance to organizations working to advance the leadership and vision of young, Black, queer, feminists and immigrant leaders."

The military's highest court upheld the conviction of a **US Marine** court-martialed for disobeying an order to remove three Bible passages she posted around her workplace.

During the **Olympics** Nike featured a transgender athlete in an ad.

President Obama recently commuted the sentences of 214 inmates, bringing his total to 562 commutations -- more than the previous nine presidents combined.

A transgender woman (a man) is suing the city of Chicago because of a city statute that will not allow him to show his fake breasts at bars or clubs that serve alcohol.
