The House Select Panel on Infant Lives has released a list of nine criminal and regulatory referrals against abortion providers and/or fetal tissue procurement companies as a result of the investigation into illegally selling baby body parts.

The **National Governors Association** will take a more public role in repealing Obamacare.

The US House has passed by a vote of 392-66 the **21st Century Cures Act**, a medical innovation bill aimed at curing diseases.

The Labor Department's new overtime rule has been temporarily blocked by a federal judge. It would have required employers to pay overtime to most salaried workers who earn less than \$47,476 annually, a much higher threshold than the current annual salary limit of \$23,660.
