News From Around PA State Reps. Cris Dush, Seth Grove and Jim Christiana released a report indicating PA spent \$30.4 billion in state and federal funds from July through October. sometimes dipping into unused monies from as far back as 2005 even as the budget impasse continues. However, as schools and non-profits which receive government funds struggle, none of the money went to them. Instead it went to such things as subscription services and membership dues. Governor Wolf used a waiver process to keep moving through money Harrisburg, as past governors have, but his requests were vague, thus raising questions

If the State Senate votes to remove **Kathleen Kane** as Attorney General, Governor Wolf says he's not sure how he will response, since he is still "grappling" with what the constitution means.

A constitutional amendment to raise the mandatory retirement age for judges from 70 to 75 will appear on the primary ballot.
