News From Around PA PA Choose Life License Plates were approved in 2007, since then 1,430 have been sold bringing in \$28,600. Membership for PA Choose **Life** is \$52.00 per year for the first year. The membership fee includes the PA Choose Life License Plate. After covering the costs incurred from Penn DOT for the plates the rest of the \$52.00 fee goes directly to charities supporting pro-life causes those and in crisis pregnancies. PA Choose Life, Inc. asks that you renew your \$20.00 membership fee each year at the time of your vehicle registration.

SB 3, the Pain Capable Abortion Prevention Act and ban on dismemberment abortions passed in the State House by a vote of 121 to 70. Click here to read how your House member voted.

It now heads to Governor Wolf's desk.

News from National Scene Treasury Dept. found that pretax household income of same-sex married couples is higher than that heterosexual married couples. Mostly driven by the average earnings of male same-sex couples: \$176,000. On average, they make \$52,000 more than married lesbian couples and \$63,000 more than married "straight" couples.

2ndVote released tax documents revealing that the **Players Association** donated \$5,000 in 2015 to the Center for Community Change Action. which receives money from many leftist, including George Soros.
