PA's unemployment rate

**West York Borough** has proposed an ordinance to decriminalize possession of small amounts of marijuana.

Governor Tom Wolf has announced his support for former **Secretary of Labor Tom Perez** for Chair of the Democratic National Comm.

A suspended female teacher and former coach in the Williamsport Area School District will have her day in court to face charges including aggravated, institutional and indecent assault for her alleged sexual relations with two of her female students.

**News from National Scene** Fox Ridge Middle School in Colorado is making pornographic material (i.e. erotica. advice on performing certain acts, propaganda, homosexual information on bondage) accessible as part of their sex ed curriculum. Parents of one middle schooler stumbled upon it when they were checking their child's password access at school. When they confronted the school about it, the parents were accused of breaking school policy by logging on to the materials!

Rules finalized on December 9th require companies to track the origin of **each fish** imported into the U.S. Companies would have to prove where each fish or cut of meat came from, down to the ship that caught it or the farm that raised it. Fish companies have announced a lawsuit against the gov't over the new rules.
