News From Around PA PA Supreme Court Justices Kevin Max Baer and Dougherty were among numerous judges who received emails that a state ethics board deemed offensive when it filed misconduct charges against Justice Michael Eakin.

The Pittsburgh Commission on Human Relations hasn't been able to agree on someone to replace the executive director, who retired two years ago and now Mayor Bill Peduto wants them all to resign.

Monroeville City Council succumbed to pressure from the ACLU and the city's own Interfaith Ministerium and scrapped voiced prayers for a moment of silence!

Northampton County's former human resources director has filed a federal lawsuit claiming she was fired after raising an alarm last year upon learning the county's hiring practices did not include verifying whether the applicant could legally work in the US.

The PA School Boards Association is suing Gov. Tom Wolf and state Legislature, saying it's illegal and unconstitutional to withhold state/federal school aid during a budget impasse.

The Judicial Action Group has sent a letter to **Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell** asking him to "refuse to consent to the confirmation of any further

of President Obama's judicial nominees," noting that the Senate has already confirmed 320 of Obama's nominees (23 more than President Bush had at the same time).

The office of the U.N. High Commissioner for Refugees will now conduct initial screenings to see whether migrants from Honduras, El Salvador and Guatemala may qualify as refugees eligible to come to the US legally.
