Last year in Denver a man asked a baker to bake a Bible shaped cake and wanted the top of the cake to have two men holding hands and an X on top of them. According to the baker, he also wanted hateful words against "gays" on the cake, although she has not revealed what the words were. The baker said she would bake the cake, but refused to include any of the messaging. The man has filed a complaint against the baker with the Colorado's Civil Rights Division saying he was discriminated against because of his religious beliefs. These are the same folks who investigated Christian baker Jack Phillips who refused to bake a "wedding" cake for a homosexual couple.
