Executive Board of PA Board of Game Commissioners dropped a proposal to create a state game lands user permit for hikers.

PA Congressman Charlie Dent (R-15) helped scuttle House vote on abortion ban after 20 weeks, saying, "I prefer that we avoid these very contentious social issues."

News from National Scene

More than 20,000 **"dreamers" in Arizona** have received work permits through Obama's Delayed Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program. A judge has just ruled that they can also obtain drivers' licenses.

Last year in **Denver** a man asked a baker to bake a Bible shaped cake and wanted the top of the cake to have two men holding hands and an X on top of them. According to the baker, he also wanted hateful words against "gays" on the cake, although she has not revealed what the words were. The baker said she would bake the cake, but refused to include any of the messaging. The man has filed a complaint against the baker with the Colorado's Civil Rights Division saying he was discriminated against

because of his religious beliefs. These are the same folks who investigated Christian baker Jack Phillips who refused to bake a "wedding" cake for a homosexual couple.

"Dismemberment" **abortions** refer to procedures in which doctors use surgical instruments, such as sharp-toothed forceps, to twist and tear away the limbs of a living fetus to cause its death. Kansas state Sen. Garrett Love will introduce the first ever bill to ban the procedure.
