News From Around PA

Philadelphia **Congressman Chaka Fattah** (D-2) has been indicted in connection with bribery schemes and misuse of hundreds of thousands of dollars in federal, charitable and campaign funds.

Homosexual activists want to force the **Cradle of Liberty Scout Counsel** to post on its website all BSA troops that exclude "gay" leaders due to religious values.

In 2015 large-scale black mob violence is now an accepted part of life in the **Pittsburgh area**. The latest example came last week, when hundreds of black people rioted outside of a carnival at St. Basil's parish. No one in the press called it a riot. Neither did they identify the hundreds of people involved as black. A few cops and residents took care of that in emails. Why?

Because in 2011 the Black Political Empowerment Project held a "media summit" and asked the media to do fewer stories about black criminals and the media readily complied. As for the carnival at St. Basil's parish . . . well they have permanently cancelled the 40-year tradition for the "safety of its parishioners."

News from National Scene

A court issued a temporary restraining order blocking the **Center for Medical Progress** from releasing any video of leaders of StemExpress, a California company that provides "fetal tissue" to researchers and contracts with Planned Parenthood. Also, the National Abortion Federation sued in federal court in San Francisco, alleging the Center for Medical Progress infiltrated its meetings and recorded its members. The group says release of any audio or video would put members in danger. A judge blocked the release of any such videos until the lawsuit has worked its way through the court system.

The National Executive Board of the **Boy Scouts of America**

voted 45-12 to allow openly homosexual adults to be troop leaders. There is an exception for troops sponsored by religious organizations; homosexual activists have said they will fight to have this removed.

New Jersey **Governor Chris Christie** vetoed a bill that would have allowed for the creation of legal gestational-surrogacy agreements, in which intended parents can be legally named at birth.

Louisiana's **Obamacare** health insurance co-op will be closing its doors by the end of 2015. It has suffered a net operating loss of \$23 million and is the second Obamacare healthcare co-op to close this year.
