Johnstown City Council voted 4-2 to table an amendment that would have added 'sexual orientation and gender identity or expression' to the city's anti-discrimination ordinance.

KennettSquareBoroughCouncil(ChesterCounty)

voted to pass an antidiscrimination ordinance with the words "sexual orientation and gender identity or expression."
