News From Around PA If passed HB 303, introduced by State Rep Mark Cohen, "students would be able to follow the dress code, use facilities such as locker rooms and restrooms, and participate athletic in programs based on students' self-attested gender."

The **FCC** has finally released its 400 pages of internet rule changes, replacing 18 years of "light-touch" regulatory policy with antiquated rules first devised in the 1930s. Exactly what will be prohibited to consumers is still unknown, as the rules leave final decisions to the discretion of regulators.

Last month US Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader **Ginsburg** said during an interview with Bloomberg, "America has come a long way in recent years on the issue of gay rights and is now ready to accept same-sex marriage as national law." A judge disqualifies himself or herself when, according to the American Bar Association's Rule 2.11(5): "The judge, while a judge or

a judicial candidate, has made a public statement, other than in a court proceeding, judicial decision, or opinion, that commits or appears to commit the judge to reach a particular result or rule in a particular way in the proceeding or controversy."
