News From Around PA A senior at **Central York High School** received a three day in-school suspension asking Miss America to the prom during a question and answer session at school. He stood up and popped the prom question, then walked to the stage with a plastic flower. He just laughed and the students cheered. School officials heard about the young man's plan in advance and warned him not to do it.

About 318,000 in PA have signed up for **Obamacare**. But the feds aren't telling whether these individuals were previously insured or if they've paid their first month's premiums.

Title IX complaints by the Women's Law Project have been filed against Bloomsburg, Cheyney,

Clarion, Indiana, Kutztown, Lock Haven, Mansfield, Millersville and Shippensburg Universities. The group says "data from each of the universities show significant gaps between enrollment of female students and their participation rates in athletic programs."

On Tuesday US District Judge John E. Jones declared PA's Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) unconstitutional. On Wednesday Governor Tom Corbett said he would not appeal the decision, becoming only the second Republican governor not to appeal such a decision.

On Monday U.S. District Judge Michael McShane struck down **Oregon's Marriage Protection**Amendment which 54% of voters approved in 2004.
