News From Around PA

A young man has come forward and accused **Jerry Sandusky** of sexually abusing him while attending a football camp at Penn State in 1988. Attorney General Kathleen Kane has decided not to approve a criminal sexual abuse complaint in this case because the statute of limitations has run out.

Christopher Lee, former CEO of the **Boal Mansion Museum** in Boalsburg, is accused of bringing foreign minors into the country with intent to molest them, coercing and enticing minors into sexual activity, producing and possessing child pornography and tampering with evidence.

The **Public Interest Law Center of Philadelphia** and the Education Law Center, on behalf of six school districts, seven parents, the

Pennsylvania Association of Rural and Small Schools (PARSS) and the NAACP Pennsylvania Chapter argue that the state's current funding mechanism isn't "adequate" to provide the "thorough and efficient public education" promised in the state constitution – and the court should force the Legislature to appropriate more money for education. Commonwealth Court threw out the lawsuit; the plaintiffs are appealing to the PA Supreme Court.

News From National Scene

The **5th Circuit Court of Appeals** announced it will hear oral arguments on July 10 in New Orleans in the Obama administration's attempt to lift a preliminary injunction from U.S. District Judge Andrew Hanen of Texas, which blocked executive amnesty from taking effect.

Bill Nye, the Science Guy, was recently interviewed by Vox. In his response about global warming he said, "When you have people denying this basic process, and how we all got here, it's offensive to me intellectually. And I happen

to think it's unpatriotic. Article I, Section 8 of the Constitution says the government shall 'promote the progress of science and useful arts.' So if you're a politician looking to derail the progress of science, I think you're not doing your job." Does it really say that?

Apparently the **US State Department** has found Cuba had not provided any support for international terrorism during the previous six-months, and had promised not to support acts of international terrorism in the future. Thus, John Kerry has announced they will be removed from the list of state sponsors of terror.
