The US House voted to repeal the **Independent Payment Advisory Board** (death panels). Four PA Congressmen voted 'no:' Robert Brady, Matthew Cartwright, Michael Doyle and Dwight Evans.

University of Pennsylvania law professor, **Stephanos Bibas**, was confirmed 53-43 to serve on Third Circuit Court of Appeals. Senator Casey voted 'nay.' This court covers Delaware, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and the Virgin Islands.

U.S. District Judge Edward G. Smith says **Lehigh County** has six months to erase its seal — ruled unconstitutional because it features a

Christian cross — from county buildings, vehicles, forms and anywhere else it appears under an agreement with four county residents who claimed the seal violates their right to be free from religion. The county will appeal to the Third Circuit.

Meadville Halloween Parade included Crawford Area LGBT+ participating as a 'walking' float.

Homosexual group New Hope Celebrates will coordinate the **Northeast Regional Pride Conference** in 2019 in New Hope (Bucks).

Philadelphia again received a perfect score on the **Human Rights Campaign's Municipal Equality Index**. With bonus points included, Pittsburgh (97) and Allentown (91) also were given a 100. Other Pennsylvania cities' raw scores were: Carlisle (70), Erie (37), Harrisburg (54), New Hope (76), Reading (64), State College (71) and Wilkes-Barre (58).

US Health and Human Services is beginning new research regarding **teen pregnancy prevention and sexual risk avoidance**
