News From Around PA A federal judge ruled the Ten Commandments monument outside Connellsville Area Junior High School violated the Amendment. First However, he did not order it removed because those who were "offended" by the monument have moved from the district. Seeking to prevent another lawsuit, the school moved the Ten Commandments to а neighboring church property. In its previous location, it was seen by very few people. It now sits next to a driveway visible to anyone approaching the high school!

Philadelphia is removing "Men" and "Women" labels from single occupancy public restrooms. Transgender activists say it "is a small step in eliminating harassment/discrimination

of transgender people." Businesses have 90 days to comply or face a fine.
