News From Around PA
A new report by the US Dept.
of Treasury shows same-sex
"married" couples made up
just 0.35 percent of all
married couples in 2014. In
PA it was only 0.26 percent
out of more than 2.25 million
married couples in 2014.
Remember Judge John Jones
struck down PA's Defense of
Marriage Act May 20, 2014.

The PA Supreme Court has а rejected motion bv plaintiffs to return the question of a constitutional amendment raising the retirement age of judges from 70 to 75 to the Commonwealth Court. Plaintiffs have not given up and will refile the case in Commonwealth Court.

House Bill 880 passed in February 2016, delaying the implementation of the **Keystone** graduation requirement until the 2018-

2019 school year. This would require all high school seniors in PA to take and pass tests in Algebra I, Biology, and Language Arts in order to earn a diploma. The PA Dept. of Ed is ignoring the law and issuing directives to local school districts to use the Keystone Exams now for graduation if they want!

The White House recently sponsored an LGBT Summit in Pittsburgh. It was attended by 130 PA LGBT activists. US departments of Health and Human Services, Agriculture Justice, and Housing and Urban Development shared information about their current LGBT initiatives.

The **Senate Government Committee** has postponed a Sept. 26th hearing on two homosexual special rights bills - SB 974 and SB 1316.
