News From Around PA The American Academy of Adoption Attorneys and the American Academy of Assisted Reproductive Technology Attorneys will host their first Family Building Expo in Philadelphia on September 20th. The expo aims to be "inclusive of all families and individuals and is welcoming to the LGBT community."

Homosexuals are livid because **South Williamsport High School** administrators have stopped the 2015 production of Monty Python's Spamalot due to "controversial content." In the musical, Sir Lancelot "marries" his boyfriend.

State **Senate Law and Justice Committee**, announced that the Committee passed Senate Bill 1182 establishing access to medical marijuana in Pennsylvania. It now goes to the full Senate.

In a unanimous vote, **State College Borough Council** agreed in supporting the overturning of the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling in the Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission decision, a case dealing with corporate campaign contributions.

News from National Scene A high school principal in Ventura, CA has banned the football booster club from selling Chick-fil-A sandwiches during a back-to-school night fundraiser because she disagrees about same-sex marriage with the president of the fast-food chain.

Health economist **John Goodman** noted that three Federal Reserve Banks in Philadelphia, New York and Atlanta have surveyed businesses in their area and roughly one fifth of the employers are saying they cut back on employment because of Obamacare.

Sen. Dianne Feinstein (D.-Calif.), the chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, said that if President Obama bypasses Congress and takes unilateral action on immigration "it would be legally challenged."

The New York City St. Patrick's Day Parade committee has announced that it will allow OUT@NBC Universal, a qay group associated with the television network that broadcasts the event, to officially join the march under its own banner next year. Other homosexual groups are still pushing for admittance.
