Highmark posted a \$171 million operating loss for the first half of 2015, with company officials saying sicker-than-expected insureds cost \$318 million more than the company collected through June 30. The insurer is seeking rate increases of 25 to 30 percent for many of the plans it will offer on the federal marketplace for 2016.

after a "transgender woman" (a man biologically) was attacked. The news release "did not qualify her as a trans woman or misgender her in any way."

In 35-page petition Philadelphia asked the state Supreme Court to review a lower-court ruling exempting SEPTA from adherence to the city's sexual orientation /gender identity laws. The 2009 lawsuit was filed because SEPTA had placed gender stickers transpasses. Since then the plaintiff has died and the stickers are no longer placed on the passes, but the attorneys are thinking monetary damages may be awarded to "her" estate.
