MARRIAGE PROTECTION AMENDMENT

<u>Due to the recent Iowa Supreme Court ruling declaring that state's Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) unconstitutional,</u>

Pennsylvanians and their legislators can no longer assume our DOMA will protect marriage.

- 1. **We**, the undersigned, ask our Pennsylvania Lawmakers to **PROTECT** the establishment of traditional marriage between one woman and one man by way of **a** Constitutional Amendment. Give Pennsylvanians the opportunity to vote on the definition of marriage.
