**Pennridge School District** (Bucks County) will be voting on a revised bathroom policy on April 22<sup>nd</sup>. The revised policy would establish three bathroom options — singleuser bathrooms, multi-user bathrooms and gender-based bathrooms.

The Pennsylvania **State Boards of Psychology and Osteopathic Medicine** voted to adopt new policies opposing the use of "conversion therapy" on minors in PA. This is simply talk therapy!!

News From National Scene Sutton High School in Massachusetts recently held a sexualized adult-themed drag show. Reportedly the "drag queen" made inappropriate comments and exposed his "panties" to students.

Did you know in 2013: the American **Psychiatric Diagnostic and Statistical** Association's Manual of Mental Disorders "noted that most kids who experience distress with their sexed bodies resolve those feelings after they pass through natural puberty." Experts say so-called genderthat affirming care actually and prolongs deepens feelings of gender dysphoria that would otherwise go away on their own.

An Arizona state auditor's office recently completed a review that found no proof there is any wrongdoing on the part of Grand Canyon University (GCU), but two federal agencies are continuing with their the campaigns against Christian university despite the findings. GCU representative Bob Romantic said the university continues to be "targeted" by what he described as "systemic attacks being made against GCU that we believe are retaliation for filing our lawsuit against the DOE (US Dept. of Education)."

The outdoor brand The North Face, as well as shoe companies Toms and Chacos are sponsors of Camp Brave Trails. This is an overnight summer camp where children as young as 12 years old who identify as LGBT are encouraged to perform in drag. The camp founders say, "All of our housing is genderless, bathrooms are genderless, we ask for names and pronouns from campers and they can change them all they like."

The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics voted to ban males who identify as women from women's sports starting next school year, affecting a total of 241 colleges with <u>80,000</u> <u>athletes.</u>
