celebrated 50 years since PA Governor Milton Shapp signed executive order adding 'sexual orientation' to protected classes for state employees. He was the first in the nation to do so.

The primary election will include the choice of mayor in **Downingtown Borough**. On the Dems ballot are long-time resident Barry Cassidy and Erica Deuso. Except Erica is NOT a woman, but a man who identifies as a woman. LGBTQ activists are saying this "campaign lends essential visibility to transgender and other gender nonconforming Americans". The Chester County Dems would not endorse Cassidy because he had "positions that didn't align with the Democratic Party". One of those views was on transgenderism!

News From National Scene

West Virginia Governor

Patrick Morrissey signed legislation into law reaffirming and strengthening the rights of parents to direct the education and upbringing of their children.

Arkansas Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders signed legislation okaying displays of the Ten Commandments in classrooms.

The **Boston Marathon** features three divisions – men, women, and non-binary. However, this year, for the first time, the Boston Marathon allowed men to compete in the women's division.

Adidas is a major sponsor of the Boston Marathon. Apparently, Adidas does not see the conflict as they have launched a major ad campaign promoting women in sports!

University of Louisville has agreed to pay almost \$1.6 million in damages and attorneys' fees to settle a six-year-old lawsuit filed by its former chief of the Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Psychology, who was fired

for criticizing transgender ideology.

The **National Endowment for the Humanities** (NEH) awarded a \$60,000 grant to Northeastern music Professor Francesca Inglese prior to President Trump taking office. The grant will fund her book project: "Dark Angels: Black Violinists and the Race of Musical Instruments". The NEH awarded nearly \$2.4 million in DEI-related grants to higher education.

Boulder Valley Health Center, an abortion clinic in Colorado, - a free "Sex Ed Summer Camp" for 5th thru 8th graders, to teach them about gender ideology and "everything related to sex, bodies, sexuality, sexy feelings, and justice."
