State Senator Nikil Saval, a Democrat from Philly, began circulating a co-sponsorship memo to establish **universal healthcare in PA**. Who would be eligible? "Every person residing in the commonwealth and all non-residents working at least 20 hours per week in Pennsylvania." How will it be paid for? "Coverage will be provided without copays, deductibles, coinsurance, or caps. The program will be funded through a payroll tax."

Did you know that on June 26th **Governor Shapiro announced** a \$10.65 million grant to flu vaccine manufacturer Sanofi Pasteur - just 60 days before the Lancaster press conference announcing two "measles-associated" deaths -- and \$21 million in commonwealth support for a GSK vaccine-manufacturing expansion in Lancaster County. Additional commonwealth-backed investment has gone to Eli Lilly, Johnson & Johnson/Janssen Biotech, Eurofins Lancaster

Laboratories. The governor did not mention any of this.

What is the difference between "measles-associated" and "measles-related"? WHO defines a "measles-related death" as a death in someone with a positive measles test that occurs within 30 days of a measles rash onset "and is not due to other unrelated causes" such as trauma. The Lancaster County corner reports that the infant the PA Department of Health claims is a "measles-associated" death is actually a newborn who died from a lacerated spleen! The coroner knows nothing of the other Lancaster County individual who supposedly was a "measles-associated" death.

Protect Our Care, a Democrat health advocacy group, has concluded that "vaccines are on the ballot" and that vaccine policy was the GOP's greatest midterm weakness. When PA announced the deaths on Aug. 25, Protect Our Care immediately stated that Trump and Kennedy had fueled the crisis, "resulting in" the deaths. Shapiro's office has worked

closely with Protect Our Care since 2020 -coincidence??

North Anderson Community Church Presbyterian (PCUSA) in Anderson, SC recently hired a pastor who identifies as a **transgender lesbian**. The church's average attendance is between 20 and 30 weekly.

The PCUSA lost more than 26,000 members and 128 congregations in 2025. As the denomination has become more liberal, its membership has cratered from 2.5 million in 2000 to just over 1 million.
