3, 2024 August Printable Remember: versions found online News from Around PA Baldwin-Whitehall. Fox Chapel and Shaler Area school districts in Allegheny County as well as Hempfield Area in Westmoreland and Seneca Valley in Butler would be exempt from the new Title IX rules which change the definition of sex to include sexual orientation and gender identity. These districts were featured on a list submitted to a Kansas court which barred enforcement of the new Title IX rules in those schools. The Biden Administration is appealing the ruling. LGBTQ advocates in PA are saying no PA school should be exempt because of the Kansas ruling.

Bindr, the Pittsburgh-based bisexual, lesbian, and LGBTQ dating app, just won the first 2SLGBTQIA+ Entrepreneur Prize sponsored by QueerTech and presented at StartupFest.

Temple Emanuel of South Hills in Pittsburgh has a nonbinary cantor. "They" is one of three nonbinary Cantors, all of whom were ordained from the same cohort in '23. The watchdog group the Freedom Foundation has filed three complaints with state and federal authorities which outline a scheme in which the Pennsylvania State Education Association (PSEA) illegally laundered \$1.5 million from its general treasury through the Fund for Student Success to the Democratic Governors Association, which in turn contributed to Josh Shapiro's 2022 gubernatorial campaign.

<u>From</u> National Scene In the Southern Poverty Law **Center's (SPLC)** magazine "Year in Hate and Extremism", the article "Fighting Illiteracy, Preserving Democracy: The Power of Drag Story Hour" claims the real purpose of Drag Queen Story Hours is to fight childhood illiteracy by encouraging children to read books like Gender Fairy, Adventures with my Daddies, Jack (Not Jackie), Daddy and Dada and Jacob's School Play: Starring He, She and They. Remember no matter what the SPLC's original purpose may have been it is now a pro-LGBTQ, pro-abortion group that labels groups like the AFA of PA as 'hate groups"!

The International Boxing Association sent test results to the International Olympic Committee (IOC) more than a vear ago that showed "female" Algerian boxer Imane Khelif had the DNA of a 'male'.
