Last October **Perkiomen Valley School District's** (Montco) Republican-controlled board passed Policy 720, which mandated that students could only use bathrooms designated for their biological sex. The November election flipped the board and by a margin of 7-2 the Democrat-majority voted to rescind the policy.

The **7th Annual Condom Fashion Show** will be held at the Asian Arts Initiative in Philly. It is "an event that bridges sexual health and creativity by turning what's typically worn in private into outfits for the catwalk." The organizers say it is a "call for Comprehensive Sex Ed for all K-12 students."

Recently the **Philadelphia Free Library** hosted a lecture by Gary Hines called "Black & Queer in Philadelphia: From the 1930s to Today." He closed his remarks by saying, "'Some of these people need historical markers.'"

News From National Scene

Seattle, WA **English students** taught the love of reading and reading is "white supremacy".

Longtime **NCAA** committee member, William Bock, has resigned in protest against their policies saying, "I have watched the NCAA double down on regressive policies, which discriminate against female student-athletes."

The **Indiana GOP Attorney General** has set up a website for parents to report instances of ideological indoctrination in their children's classrooms. It allows parents to submit complaints complete with pictures or documents if applicable, a link to Indiana's Parents Bill of Rights.

Facebook took down a user's post claiming that celebrating "white heterosexual pride month" goes against their guidelines because it "praises or supports people and organizations we define as dangerous."

The Australian surfing company **Rip Curl** is taking heat for hiring a male-born transgender model as one of its new "female brand ambassadors." This just months after parting ways with Bethany Hamilton, the surfer famed for losing her arm to a shark attack because she criticized male athletes competing as women. Recently in Springfield, MO, she joined Riley Gaines at a public library children's story hour. When transgender activists could not get the library to cancel, they tried to disrupt the event.

Fairfax County, VA school board has put a "**sex therapist**" who promotes "kinky" acts like BDSM to the Challenged Materials Interdepartmental Review Committee to review complaints from taxpayers about inappropriate books.
