According to the editorial board of the campus newspaper and a student government leader, Penn State's annual fundraiser THON that raises money to help kids suffering from cancer is too white.

News From National Scene

The website of California State University Monterey Bay's Personal Growth and Counseling Center tells students how they should cope with racism and discrimination in order to "maximize one's academic potential." "Don't ignore or

minimize your experiences, and think broadly about what could be an act of racism. It doesn't have to be an overt act (e.g., professor consistently not calling on you or minimizing your contributions, curriculum racially biased, etc)." Students are advised to report the incident.

The nation's largest LGBTQ lobby group, the Human Rights Campaign, recently held its eighth annual "Welcoming Schools National Day of Reading: A Celebration of Stories Supporting Transgender and Non-Binary Youth" The event is also sponsored by the National Education Association and the American Association of School Librarians.

Fox News contributor Bruce "Caitlyn" Jenner has announced support for a bill that "turn(s) Minnesota into a trans refuge state by protecting trans people, their families, and medical practitioners from legal repercussions for traveling to Minnesota to receive gender-affirming care."

The Washington University Transgender Center in St. Louis is under investigation by the state's attorney general. In a 32-page sworn affidavit, a whistleblower said, the center is "using experimental drugs on children, distributing puberty blockers and cross-sex hormones without individualized assessment, and even giving children these life-altering drugs without parental consent."

The North Dakota House approved a bill that would make it a crime to perform drag shows and cabaret performances in the presence of children or in public places.

The Department of Defense will pay the travel expenses of service members seeking abortions or fertility treatments and grant them paid leave while obtaining it.
