News From Around PA

Retired **Olympic swimmer Nancy Hogshead-Makar** wrote a letter to the University of Pennsylvania on behalf of sixteen members of the women’s swimming team asking the school not to legally challenge USA Swimming’s new policy regarding male swimmers who identify as female. The letter noted that U Penn swimmer “Lia” Thomas’ (who swam three years on the men’s team) rankings bounced from #462 as a male to # 1 as a female!

Governor Wolf is going around the General Assembly to force PA into the **Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative** (RGGI). This would impose a tax on carbon dioxide emissions from fossil-fired power plants. Wolf has taken the Pennsylvania Bulletin, which publishes the weekly official record of PA state government agency action, to court because it has refused to publish the regulation. Once published it would take immediate effect. Wolf wants a court order to force the publication of the RGGI regulation.

With the election of **Ed Gainey** to be Pittsburgh’s next mayor, his State House seat in District 24 is vacant. The founder of New Voices for Reproductive Justice, La’Tasha Mayes, has announced her candidacy!

15 Philly-based companies received a perfect score in **HRC’s Corporate Equality Index**, showing how LGBTQ+ inclusive they are. These include: Aberdeen Standard Investments, Aramark Corp, Chubb Ltd., Comcast NBC Universal, FMC Corp.

News From National Scene

USA Swimming, which oversees competitive swimming in the US, recently announced an “Athlete Inclusion, Competitive Equity and Eligibility Policy.” In general, biological male swimmers seeking to compete on women’s teams will have to prove that they have had consistently low testosterone levels for the three-year period leading up to their application to compete in women’s swimming.

The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals allowed Tennessee’s ban on abortions based upon a Down Syndrome diagnosis to be reinstated.

The Anti-Defamation League has changed its definition of racism to “oppression of people of color through systems that privilege white people.” This change aligns it to CRT -critical race theory.

Tampa Bay Delivery Service, an Amazon service, will pay a former employee \$50,000 for religious discrimination. It had been made clear earlier that he would not work Sundays so he could attend church. However, the company scheduled him to work a Sunday shift and fired him when he attended church instead.

The nomination of radical, anti-religious freedom **Gigi Sohn** to the Federal Communications Commission has been pulled!
