News from Around PA

On Wednesday, January 7, **Erie City Council** unanimously elected Dr. Tyler Titus council president. With this election, "they became the first openly transgender person" in the commonwealth to hold that position. He previously served on the Erie School District board.

In a new "**Battle of the Sexes**" tennis match, Nick Kyrgios, the 673rd-ranked player on the men's circuit, defeated Aryna Sabalenka, the #1 women's player in the world. Two professors and two PhD students from Penn State were worried how the outcome — and the match in general — would affect "gender equity".

A running tally of wagers kept by **Legal Sports Report** shows gamblers in PA have wagered \$43.06 billion on sports from January through mid-November 2025.

News from National Scene

The radical group **Shout Your Abortion** has produced a little 32-page book for five to eight-year-olds. The theme of the book is that abortion is a "superpower," and the title says it all: "Abortion Is Everything."

On January 13th **Borden County**, Texas became the 17th county in the nation and the 15th county in Texas to pass a Sanctuary County for the Unborn Ordinance.

Louisiana has indicted **California abortionist Remy Coeytaux** for trafficking illegal abortion pills into the state. Attorney General Liz Murrill has requested his extradition. The following day California Governor Gavin Newsome denied the request saying, "We will not allow extremist politicians from other states to reach into California and try to punish doctors."

Colorado Democrats have introduced a bill **removing parental rights**. If passed it would allow a child to change his or her name, suppress records showing a name change, and allow the court to strip away parents' rights if they do not "affirm" their child's new name.

The **Republican Study Committee** unveiled a budget framework which includes permanently defunding large abortion providers such as Planned Parenthood. The one-year freeze, signed into law by President Trump as part of the tax overhaul last year, already had a major impact on Planned Parenthood.
