News From Around PA Governor Wolf hopes to legalize same day voter registration and no-excuse absentee ballots.

Wolf has also set a priority of widening PA's homosexual special rights policies, making the passing of the **PA Fairness Act** a direct priority for the LGBTQ Commission and his administration.

A lesbian couple from Philly planned to "marry" at the Le Blanc Spa Resort in Cancun, Mexico next November, but were turned down. They will be filing a complaint with the Mexican government.

The Sero Project is planning to form a PA network of People Living with HIV (PLHIV). The purpose is to end "criminal prosecutions of people with HIV, including for non-disclosure of their HIV status, potential or perceived HIV exposure or HIV transmission."

The2018NationalMovement Reportprovides a

comprehensive and standardized look at the LGBT movement's finances for Fiscal Year 2017 across 40 major LGBT advocacy organizations. The total combined 2017 revenue (including in-kind) for the participating organizations was \$269.7 million-up 13% from 2016. Analyzing the first full year under Trump, it showed how attacks on President Trump have led to increased donations.

News From National Scene The ACLU has filed suit against the LaFayette Public Library in Louisiana after officials decided to ban Drag Queen Story Time.

The **ACLU of Florida** has filed a legal brief with the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals defending a "transgender woman" (biological man) in his demands that he be given access to "medically necessary care for her gender dysphoria" i.e. hormones and female clothing.

In 2019 LGBT activists are hoping to get at least four more states-Colorado, Maine, New York, Massachusetts -- to pass **bans on talk therapy** for minors with unwanted same sex attraction.

Steve Cohen (D-TN) has introduced a bill in the US House to eliminate the electoral college.

The US DOJ has filed a supportive statement of interest in a federal court case involving a Christian group, **Business Leaders in Christ,** at the University of lowa that had been derecognized. The university concluded the group had violated its Human Rights Policy for not allowing an open homosexual to serve as vice president.
