A **Connecticut father** of four said he recently pulled his kids from the public school system and plans to homeschool them after elementary officials reportedly showed a pridethemed video to students.

Major League Baseball has quietly told teams that they can stop forcing players to wear uniforms and hats adorned with gay pride rainbow colors during their "Pride Night" games. Up to this point, the Texas Rangers is the only team that has refused to hold "Pride Night".

A **Hixson Middle School** teacher in Tennessee has apologized for forcibly taking a cross necklace from a student during a book fair. The school had no rules against the student wearing the necklace.

This upcoming school year, the Arlington Public Schools in Virginia is revising its grading policies to create "equitable grading

processes". The new policies allow students to redo assignments, turn in late work, and reduce the weight given to homework and quizzes. Schools in neighboring Fairfax County approved the same policies with poor results!

The all-Muslim city council of **Hamtramck, MI** voted unanimously to approve a resolution that would ban the LGBTQ+ pride flag from being flown on the city's property.

During the Marshall Simonds Middle School (Burlington, MA) "spirit day" celebration for Pride Month, students tore down pride banners and chanted "U.S.A." are my pronouns! These students also wore red, white and blue clothing and face paint instead of the suggested rainbow-colored attire. School administrators likened the actions to violence.
