Senators Scott Martin and Ryan Aument have introduced SB 1278, the "Empowering Parents in Education" bill. According to the co-sponsorship memo, it prohibit classroom instruction on gender identity and sexual orientation for pre-kindergarten through fifth grade students,

News From National Scene President Biden has signed an executive order expanding "LGBTQ+ rights". It calls on the Dept. of Health and Human Services to draft sample policies to "expand access to comprehensive health care for LGBT+ patients"; encourages the Federal Trade Commission to consider whether "so-called conversion therapy" constitutes an unfair or deceptive practice and whether to issue consumer warnings; and calls on the Dept. of Education to release a sample school policy for "achieving full inclusion for LGBTQ students".

ZooMontana in Billings. Montana is planning a Drag Queen Story Hour on June 22nd. Many in the community are pushing back, but the director posted on Facebook, "Let me be clear ZooMontana prides itself in being inclusive of all living beings. 406 Pride is a valued respected and community asset, one we are proud to support and host at ZooMontana,"

In a 5-2 decision the New York State Court of Appeals rejected a petition by the animal rights organization Nonhuman Rights Project, affirming lower court rulings. The organization requested a writ of habeas corpus to take Нарру, a female Asian elephant brought to the Bronx Zoo in 1977, away from the z00. The group contended that Happy was a person and illegally confined.

In Illinois, Oak Park and River
Forest High School

administrators will require teachers to adjust classroom grading scales to account for skin color or ethnicity of its students beginning next year.

Also in Illinois: a **Lyons Township** High School teacher has resigned citing "immoral" the following policing: Homework Not Scored; No Assignment Due Date; Unending Revisions of Homework Required; Equal-Interval Grading, Reinforcement of D Grades (students get credit for doing nothing).
