#### **News from Around PA**

On June 16<sup>th</sup> House Democrats again showed their hate for school choice as the **House Education Committee** passed, along party lines, two anti-education bills. HB 2632 would slash \$102 million from funding for K–12 scholarship organizations i.e. EITC and OSTC, which are funded by private donations. HB 2634 would cut funding to all charter schools. As Democrats bow to the wishes of the teachers’ unions, tens of thousands of PA students are harmed!

Democrat-controlled **Luzerne County** has passed a “non-discrimination” ordinance which contains “actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender expression and gender identity” language. It impacts “employment, housing, education, health care and public accommodations”.

#### **News from National Scene**

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) joined Alaska, Iowa, Nebraska, and Texas in suing the **World Professional Association of Transgender Health (WPATH)** over alleged deceptive trade practices. FTC Chairman Andrew Ferguson argues, “WPATH made deceptive and unsubstantiated claims about the necessity, safety, and efficacy of certain drugs and surgeries used to medically transition children.” NOTE: Joe Biden’s Assistant Secretary of Health “Rachel” (Richard) Levine pressured WPATH to eliminate the age minimums for some medical interventions to promote the Biden administration’s pro-transgender political agenda.

The MLB game between the **San Francisco Giants and the Chicago Cubs** was “Pride

Night.” Giants players were expected to wear their team cap, which featured the team’s logo in rainbow colors for Pride Month. A couple players wrote Bible verses beside the rainbow logo. One Giants player left the bullpen without the rainbow cap on. Last month the LA Dodgers pitcher refused to wear a “pride month” cap.

**Major League Baseball** officially warned the players, saying the writing violated league rules. “The writing on the cap violates our rules, and consistent with normal practice, we have warned the players about future violations,” MLB chief communications officer Pat Courtney said in a statement.
