From National Scene U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana blocked an attempt by the Biden administration's Equal **Employment** Opportunity **Commission** to interpret the Pregnant Workers Fairness Act in such a way that religious organizations would be forced to pay for employees' abortions violation of their religious beliefs.

The **Comstock Act** outlaws the shipping of "every article or thing designed, adapted or intended for producing abortion" via the U.S. mail. Senators Tina Smith (D-Minn.), Elizabeth Warren (D-Mass.), and Catherine Cortez Masto (D-Nev.) introduced a bill to repeal the abortion provision of that bill.

AZ Governor Katie Hobbs (D-AZ) vetoed the Detransitioner Bill of Rights, legislation that would give individuals seeking to de-transition the same rights and

medical protections as those seeking to transition.

Victory West High School in Texas has had a tradition of providing graduating seniors with a Bible. They are set up on a table and seniors are encouraged to pick up a copy as they return to their seats. An employee of the school was "concerned" about this and contacted the Freedom From Religion Foundation, which in turn contacted the school saying their actions were unconstitutional because of the separation of church and state!!
