The following **US Supreme**

Court 6-3 opinions continue

to show a court split along

ideological lines: 1.) a district

judge does not have the

power to issue a nationwide

injunction; 2.) upheld a TX

law requiring pornography

websites to verify the age of

their users before granting

access to explicit material; 3.)

sided with Montgomery

County, MD parents who

wanted to opt their young

children out of classroom

reading sessions of LGBTQ+

books; 4.) upheld South

Carolina's law preventing

Medicaid money from going

to Planned Parenthood.

Christian Camp IdRaHaje in

Colorado has reached a

favorable agreement with the

state to keep campers

separated in single-sex

designated facilities.

In February **Maine State Rep**

Laurel Libby posted on her

Facebook page details of that

state's policy allowing boys in

girls' sports, etc. The

Democrats demanded an

apology, stripping her of her

ability to vote or even speak

on the House floor. She stood

her ground, sued the state

and the US Supreme Court

sided with her. On

Wednesday state Democrats

passed a House resolution to

fully restore her voting and

speaking rights.

University of Wisconsin-

Madison FY 2026 budget

includes \$136,000 to fund a

group that provides sexual

programming, including a 90-

minute "Ethical Porn" session

for students. The Sex Out

Loud club, billed as a "peer to

peer sexual health resource".

USNS Harvey Milk, named

pedophile, has been renamed
